SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS For 2010-2011 ACADEMIC YEAR

Dear Applicant:

The Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C will be awarding a scholarship in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to one senior in the Nueces Canyon CISD. The recipient will be required to enroll as a full-time student and carry a minimum of 12 semester hours in order to receive the funds. This enrollment may be either in a technical/vocational school or in an accredited two or four year college/university. The enrollment must be for the 2011 fall semester. Funds must be used for college expenses such as tuition, books, and/or dorm expense. Normal everyday expenses will not qualify. Recipient will be required to present receipts for all expenses and will be reimbursed for those that qualify.

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be:

- Currently enrolled as a student in the Nueces Canyon CISD and be eligible for graduation in the spring of 2011;
- Maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 during your final year of high school;
- Be a resident of the Nueces Canyon School District for a minimum of twelve months prior to your anticipated graduation date;
- Have specific plans to attend a college, university or technical training institute the fall semester following graduation; and
- Have a family Gross income of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) or less.

A Scholarship Committee will review the applications and make recommendation as to the awarding of the scholarships to the membership of the Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C. The Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C reserves the right to make final decision in the awarding of the scholarship. Applications will be graded based upon completeness, need, communication skills, and special circumstances.

Any funds not used within the specific time period will be forfeited and returned to the Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C. Should a recipient of a scholarship have special circumstances that do not allow the recipient to complete the requirements within the specified time, that individual may submit a written appeal to the Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C for an extension of time not to exceed six months in which to complete the requirements. The Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C will review and act on the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting. In all cases, the decision of the Nueces Canyon Gypsy M/C is final.

- The Application deadline is Friday April 22nd, 2011 and applications must be turned in to your school counselor on or before that date.
- Applications must be filled in completely. Do not leave any blank areas. List reasons for any incomplete information.
- **Applications, including attachments, should be typed or computer generated.** (Exception, letters of recommendation may be handwritten but must be legible. If desired, applicants may use computer to complete the required information and then cut and tape information to specific areas. A resume may be substituted for Sections I,II, and III, however, the resume must contain all of the required information)
- Computer generated applications must follow the exact format as the attached application.
